



Rooted in the past and present

UFM 100.3 Radio DJ Andrew Zhan is on a quest to conserve his apartment's storied past.

And that's exactly what he did to turn his small living space in central Singapore into a sophisticated sanctuary, expanding on the area's rich history to harmonise contemporary accents with timeless artefacts.

Andrew invited us into his cosy studio apartment to reveal his stylistic preferences and how he keeps his home uncluttered. (Spoiler: It involves his trusty Dyson vacuum!)

During my discussion with my interior designer, I recall throwing words like 'modern' and 'retro' into the conversation...

You were holding down a corporate job before UFM 100.3. Tell us more about this unconventional career pivot.

It's a cliché, it's over-said, but it's true - the pivot is essentially a result of a quarter-life crisis. I have always been a theatre kid. Back in secondary school, I was very active in my drama club, and I was surrounded by peers who were just so enthusiastic about the craft. Life kind of moved in a different direction when I majored in Business at Singapore Management University. It just seemed like I was primed for the corporate ladder climb.

As I muddled through the

grind, an opportunity came up. A friend was looking for a part-time DJ and asked if I was keen. I don't think I ever said "yes" that fast before. And I just learnt so much from the stint, having met so many new people I wouldn't have otherwise encountered and feeling as comfortable as I was in the radio station. Three-and-ahalf years later, a full-time position opened up and I gladly took that leap of faith.

In retrospect, it really was my drama teacher from secondary school who inspired me to venture beyond that safety bubble. During one of our catch-up sessions, she simply asked, "Is this a job that you feel will provide the greatest value and happiness to a life that you foresee yourself having in the future?"

Your bachelor pad is really unique: It's not every day that you see a home with its own private elevator.

The lift actually has a door on both sides, with the other facing my neighbour's apartment. So, it can be awkward when we share a lift, as I get to see his entire home when he enters the elevator. Of course, I try to look away but the last thing I want is for him to think of me as aloof. That said, it's always great to see the look of awe on first-time visitors as they go, "Woah."

The private lift never fails to make his firsttime visitors do a doubletake.

Did this inspire the home's primary colour scheme?


The house itself actually inspired this colour palette. Sage Green was the apartment's original hue, and I felt that it fits into the whole concept of "contemporary rustic". I needed a colour that echoes earthy and warm undertones to complement the various wooden fittings I had, so Sage Green was a great natural starting point. We ultimately decided on Walnut Brown to contrast the muted quality of green, inducing this artful balance between timeless serenity and inviting warmth.



How do you manage clutter?

With the compact size of my apartment, I have to get really creative when it comes to managing clutter. See those two columns at each corner of the lift? I had them installed to act as the home's main storage cabinets. Not only do they go well with the home's thematic layout, but they also store my shoe collection, travel knick-knacks and bulky household items. I also make it a point not to make needless purchases.

It is shocking how quickly clutter can accumulate when left unchecked. Now, when I see dirt or mess, I clean it immediately. Thankfully, my trusty Dyson vacuum cleaner makes the cleaning process so effortless. Share with us some insights that you've gained as a first-time homeowner.

I think the term that best encapsulates my learning journey is "wabi-sabi" (a Japanese concept that translates as "finding beauty in imperfection"). All of us, me included, want a home that is immaculate. But the reality is that every home comes with its fair share of blemishes. And it is these little imperfections that make the home feel ever more unique. I love my perfectly imperfect home!

Remember KonMari's lifechanging rule - Ask yourself if it sparks joy? Well, she expounds on this concept with kintsugi, a Japanese art that is centred around the restoration of broken items. It considers defects and imperfections as natural opportunities to grow and improve, and as we mend and reconstruct what is broken, we cultivate a unique affinity with our belongings. They then become a part of us as much as we are of them. Once, I inadvertently left a crack on the wall. I remembered googling "wall plastering", to learn how to sand, prime and paint over the gap. Admittedly, it doesn't look good even after my feeble attempts, but the home now carries a bit of me that otherwise wouldn't be there.

Name one thing you wish you could have done differently in relation to your living space.

It isn't so much a particularly poor aesthetic choice as a misguided approach to homemaking. I went into the whole process wanting the home to be perfect. Took a while for me to realise that a home can never be fully complete, as even until today, I'm still changing my furniture and fittings. It's always a work in progress, but that means the home can accommodate new ideas and inspirations whenever they come!

Let's circle back to your career. Are there any unfinished items on your checklist?

There were a few creative ideas I had for a morning show that I was eager to try out. I'm thrilled to say that I can now check those off my list! Every Monday to Friday, from 6am to 10am, I host The PLAY Show, where we not only play games with our listeners, but also exchange banter on an array of subjects! AT HOME WITH...

An unstoppable culinary duo

Two incredibly gifted chefs, one unwavering commitment to exceptional food.

he chemistry between Chef lan Tan and Magdalene Tang, chefowner of Mag's Wine Kitchen, is so palpable that it feels as if they have been cooking with one another since time immemorial. Even as lan finds himself fully in the zone, Magdalene stands by him, offering pointers as well as gentle reminders to stay safe. This very scene played out very differently just a year ago, when lan was an aspiring competitor in World Young Chef Young Waiter 2023 and Magdalene was one of its judges.

As Magdalene took him under her wing, they would later advance to the finals in Monaco where they secured a decisive victory with a brilliant Peranakan menu. We speak to the spirited mentormentee chefs.



lan: In retrospect, it really was serendipitous. I had just left my job at Seroja and was just so ready to simply

take a chill pill and relax. My friends wouldn't let me "hibernate" (thankfully). They would constantly coax me, "lan, you can't stop now!" And given how effective they were, it was inevitable that the pressure started setting in. I still have so much I have yet to see, experience and accomplish. So, I took that leap of faith, went through the first rounds of qualifying interviews and never looked back.



Before Mag's Wine Kitchen, vou were a trader in the banking industry. What led to this career pivot?

Magdalene: I thought I was getting fired (haha!). In all seriousness, I live to eat. I remember spending hours in the kitchen being my grandmother's assistant. She even got a fun-sized mortar and pestle just for me! At 12 years old, I was already cooking our family meals. When I got my first apartment, it was almost like a continuous party central. Friends would come over and I would prepare quick meals for them. Wanting to continue this pursuit, I saved enough money and started Mag's Wine Kitchen.

So you guys met for the very first time at the 2023 competition?

Magdalene: I was doing my rounds as a judge when I spotted this competitor working with fatt choy - an ingredient we rarely saw in the competition. I remembered thinking, "What the heck was this guy doing?" Whatever it was. I needed to know. As we conversed. he revealed his attempt to reinvent Nyonya Chap Chye and immediately, I got excited. Ian: I didn't know she was of Peranakan descent! Magdalene: The novelty of the dish may impress the other judges, but I know this cuisine

like the back of my hand. It was a bold pursuit, which made the stakes so much

higher.

What impressed you most about Ian?

Magdalene: His intrepid nature for sure. Can you imagine, we have some of the world's most exotic and exquisite ingredients, and he settled on a very modest selection! I asked him. "Where did you get your ingredients from?" lan: Fairprice!

Magdalene: This joker! lan: And it aligns well with my culinary ethos - to serve food that is good. honest and humble! Sure, we can always amp up our creations with performative theatrics like grilled prawns served as a flambe, but I choose to spotlight the very heart and soul of everyday cooking with relatable

What do you appreciate most about each other?

Ian: She doesn't mince her words. Magdalene tells me what I need to know, what I need to hear, no matter how brutal the truth may be. Her quidance is my secret ingredient!

Magdalene: I'm like a vampire, I feed off young people.

lan: So that's how you stay so young! Magdalene: The Achilles heel for veteran chefs is when complacency and pride get in the way of creativity. Learning never stops, regardless of age. And I do gain new insights from lan's experiences and perspective, of course, while keeping him in check!

Tell us about the recipe you're sharing.

lan: I decided on a modernised take on "jiang cong yu pian fan", otherwise known as ginger scallion sliced fish on rice. It's a reconstructed approach where the aromatics become the sauce, the rice is transformed into a textual complement and the fish replaces the rice as the base for the sauce.







Ginger Scallion Fish With Rice

Ingredients:

1 600-700g local fish of your choice

GINGER SCALLION SALSA VERDE

2.5g White Pepper
10g Ginger (minced)
10g Garlic (minced)
10g Hua Tiao Cooking Wine
25g Sesame Oil
30g Fish Sauce
100g Canola (or Corn) Oil

120g Spring Onion (chopped)

GARNISH

50g Puffed Wild Rice 10g Shio Kombu (sliced) 15g Ginger (sliced) 15g Dried Sakura Ebi

Preparation: Garnish

- 1 Soak the ginger slices in iced water for at least an hour (optimally, overnight). Pat dry and fry at low heat until golden brown.
- 2 Heat up cooking oil to a temperature above 190°C. Fry the puffed wild rice until crispy and golden brown.
- **3** Toast the sakura ebi until crispy.



Salsa Verde:

- **1** Add minced ginger, garlic and chopped spring onion into a bowl. Mix well.
- 2 Heat up oil to 200°C or until smoking point.
- 3 Stir the mixture continuously as you gradually add hot oil into the bowl of aromatics (including the pepper, Hua Tiao, sesame oil and fish sauce).

 Optional: Add 5g of sugar for a sweeter sauce.



Fish:

- 1 Reverse-butterfly your choice of fish. Then, season it with soy sauce, white pepper and Chinese cooking wine.
- 2 Steam the fish for eight to 10 minutes or until tender.
- **3** Spread the Salsa Verde evenly over the entire fish.
- **4** Garnish with sakura ebi, fried ginger slices, shio kombu slices and fried puffed wild rice and serve.



Sustainable ways to cool your home

From filling your rooms with plants to adjusting your ceiling fans, here are seven ideas that won't harm the planet.

it's nearly impossible to live and work without air-conditioning. In fact, our founding prime minister, Lee Kuan Yew, once called air-conditioning "the greatest invention of the 20th century". And if you ask us, it certainly is an indispensable asset.

Sadly, though, air-conditioning accounts for 19% of Singapore's carbon emissions. This is due to the use of hydrofluorocarbons (HFCs), which are commonly used as refrigerants in airconditioning equipment (a refrigerant is a substance that absorbs heat from the indoor environment and provides cool air as it travels through an air-conditioner system). HFCs contribute significantly to global warming, more so than other greenhouse gases like carbon dioxide.

Whether you're trying to reduce your carbon footprint or save electricity, there are ways to keep your home cool without running the air-conditioner 24/7. Here are seven that are inexpensive and environmentally friendly.

Add heat-absorbing houseplants

Plants are a natural air-cooling solution. Many houseplants absorb heat and release cool evaporated moisture into the air, which helps lower the indoor temperature slightly.

Plants also make great dehumidifiers. Humidity can make a room feel warmer than it actually is, and plants help pull this excess moisture from the air.

The best houseplants to buy for their cooling effect include the snake plant (Sansevieria trifasciata), the money plant (Epipremnum aureum), the Boston fern (Nephrolepis exaltata), the Chinese evergreen (Aglaonema), the peace lily (Spathiphyllum), the rubber plant (Ficus elastica), and aloe vera.

Keep window coverings closed during peak sunlight hours

If your windows face the sun, keep the curtains and blinds closed between 10am and 4pm. This will block the sun's rays and keep the heat out, thereby cooling your home significantly.

Investing in blackout curtains is also a good idea, as these block the light and minimise the amount of heat entering the room.

Use reflective window film

Reflective window film is designed to reflect solar heat, reduce glare and filter the sun's dangerous ultraviolet rays. This solution is especially useful if your windows face the sun and you don't have window treatments such as curtains or blinds.





Set your ceiling fan's direction counterclockwise

If you have a ceiling fan, run it so that the blades move counterclockwise. This helps push the cooler air down towards you, creating a "wind chill" effect. Tip: As fans only cool the person and not the space, you will only experience this cooling effect if you are in the room.

Dim the lights

Lights generate heat, so turning off or dimming your lamps and ceiling lights can help to cool down your space substantially.

Incandescent and halogen light bulbs also produce a lot of heat, so switch them out for LED ones, which emit very little heat. LED bulbs are also energy-saving, helping to lower your electricity bills.

Turn off appliances when not in use

Televisions, computers, gaming systems, microwave ovens, washers and dryers give off a lot of heat. To minimise heat exchanges and help bring your indoor temperature down, turn off these appliances when you're not using them.

Invest in an eco-friendly air-con system

In October 2022, the National Environmental Agency (NEA) started to phase out airconditioning equipment that uses refrigerants with a high Global Warming Potential (GWP), such as R-410A, in favour of more environmentally friendly, lower GWP options like R-32 that do not impact the ozone layer.

reparing meals and doing housework can feel like a drag, especially when you're pressed for time or exhausted. That's where certain household and kitchen appliances can help. Over the years, we've seen an increase in the number of products that make light work of some of the tasks many of us hate doing or have no time or patience for.

Automatic pet feeder: An automatic pet feeder gives you peace of mind that your furry friend will be fed on time, allowing you to focus on other important tasks. It's especially convenient when you're not around, and reduces the stress of having to rush home by a certain time to dish out your pet's meal.

Designed for dogs and cats, an automatic feeder dispenses a predetermined quantity of food at set times without human intervention. As well as helping you maintain portion control, it's a more practical and hygienic alternative to leaving extra bowls of food around in the hope that your pet will help itself whenever it's hungry.

Most feeders can be operated via an app on your phone.

Robotic vacuum cleaner:

Your regular vacuum cleaner may do a great job of removing dirt, dust, hair and debris from your floors, but "robovacs", as they're sometimes called, go one step further by cleaning areas many traditional vacuum cleaners can't reach, such as under the bed or sofa. Compact yet hefty, these rechargeable units are guided by cameras and sensors, so they know exactly where to go. Best part is, they can be programmed to do the job when you're out.

Dishwasher: Nobody looks forward to handwashing stacks of dishes and cookware at the end of a long day, which is why more people are investing in dishwashers. Whether freestanding or built-in, dishwashers clean your crockery, cutlery, pots and pans, as well as handwashing does. They also sanitise these items with hot steam at the end of every wash cycle. Other benefits to using a dishwasher: they're perfect for fragile glassware, which may break in the sink when hand-washed; they use less water compared to handwashing; and they help keep your kitchen sink clutter-free.



Steam vacuum cleaner: While a normal vacuum cleaner picks up loose debris like pet hair, dust, lint and dirt particles, a steam vacuum cleaner gives hard floors and carpeted areas a deeper clean by sanitising and sterilising these surfaces.

They're not complicated to use, and the hot vapour that's released from the nozzle loosens and removes ingrained dirt, and is also effective at killing bacteria and mould spores and minimising stubborn stains. Steam vacuum cleaners are touted as environmentally friendly because they reduce the need for bleach or other harsh chemicals.



Washer-dryer combo: This appliance combines two functions – washing and drying – in one and is a popular choice for small apartments and tight spaces. Because it's a two-in-one, it's perfect for people who don't have time to wait for a wash cycle to end and then manually transfer their clothes to the dryer. A washer-dryer combo has a smaller footprint than two standalone appliances and is generally cheaper than buying separate washer and dryer units. In terms of drawbacks, washer-dryer combos have a limited capacity, which means that you can't dry too many items at once. They also take longer to complete a full wash and dry cycle.

Sous vide machine: Almost anything can be prepared sous vide, including tougher cuts of meat, eggs, chicken breast, delicate seafood like salmon and lobster, fillet steak, and even vegetables.

Sous vide, which means "under vacuum" in French, is a cooking method hitherto employed by professional chefs. It involves placing food in a vacuum sealed bag and then heating the bag at a precise temperature in a water bath. The constant low cooking temperature prevents overcooking, resulting in perfectly tender, moist and flavourful food every time.



Dry run

Dehydrators are finding their way into kitchens, but how exactly do they work and do you need one?

How dehydrators work

A dehydrator dries food out by circulating heated air around the food for a long period of time (about several hours at a minimum). To use one, simply place the food on the provided trays. The heating element inside the dehydrator then raises the temperature of the air to between 40°C and 75°C, which is high enough to remove moisture from the food without cooking it. A fan draws air into the appliance and circulates it around the food, and air vents push the hot, moist air out.

What foods can be dehydrated?

You can dehydrate a range of foods, says Bibi Chia, Principal Dietitian at Raffles Medical Group. This includes foods that are naturally high in water and sugars, like apples, bananas, kiwis, pineapple and mango. Citrus peels can also be dehydrated as an addition to soups and teas.

Vegetables like carrots, green beans, mushrooms, kale and sweet potatoes are also ideal for dehydrating, and if you want to dehydrate meat and fish, Bibi recommends using lean cuts





and varieties (trim off any fat first, to prevent the food from going rancid, and follow food safety measures when preparing the meat and fish for dehydration).

You can also dehydrate herbs and spices, and grainbased products like noodles and pasta, Bibi adds.

Foods that aren't ideal for dehydrating include those that are high in fat or oil, like avocado and fatty meats.

"Fats tend to oxidise and turn rancid during dehydration, impacting taste and safety," says Bibi.

cucumber and watermelon are also poor candidates for dehydration.

"High-moisture foods lack the necessary structure for efficient dehydration and may turn mushy," Bibi points out.

Pros and cons of dehydrated foods

"Dehydration significantly extends the shelf life of food, reducing waste and allowing for the convenient storage of seasonal produce," says Bibi.

"Additionally, dehydration concentrates some minerals and fat-soluble vitamins like vitamin A in food, providing a potentially beneficial boost. It also retains the fibre in foods, and fibre contributes to digestive health and satiety."

Finally, dehydrated foods are lightweight and portable, making them ideal for

lunchbox snacks, hiking, camping and travel.

On the downside, Bibi says that dehydration, especially with high temperatures or prolonged drying

times, may lead to the loss of vitamins B and C, which are water-soluble. Some minerals may also leach out with the water.

Dehydration concentrates a food's natural sugars due to water removal. Fruit, for example, becomes concentrated in sugar and calories when dehydrated. While still containing fibre and some vitamins, be mindful of portion sizes to avoid overconsumption, Bibi says.

Safety tips when dehydrating food

Preventing bacteria overgrowth in dehydrated foods is crucial for safety and preservation, says Bibi. Here are her tips for safe food preservation:

Proper preparation:

Start with fresh, high-quality produce or ingredients. Thoroughly wash fruit, vegetables and herbs before dehydrating to remove dirt or contaminants.

Pre-treatment:

Some foods benefit from pretreatment methods to inhibit bacterial growth. For example, blanching vegetables in hot water for a short time before dehydration can help kill surface bacteria.

Adequate dehydration:

Ensure that foods are dehydrated properly and completely. Follow manufacturer instructions for dehydrator settings or recommended drying times. Insufficient dehydration can leave moisture behind, creating an environment for bacterial growth.

4 Storage conditions:

Store dehydrated foods properly in airtight containers or vacuum-sealed bags to prevent moisture reabsorption. Store them in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight. Moisture can lead to bacterial growth and spoilage.

Use of additives:

Consider using natural preservatives like salt, sugar or citric acid, which can inhibit bacterial growth and extend the shelf life of dehydrated foods.

Monitor for signs of spoilage:

Even with proper preparation and storage, it's essential to check dehydrated foods for any signs of spoilage such as mould, "off" smells, or changes in colour or texture. Discard any food that appears spoiled or questionable.

Practise good hygiene:

Maintain good personal hygiene and cleanliness while handling food. Wash hands thoroughly before and during food preparation to prevent contamination.

Consider vacuum sealing dehydrated foods in individual packages to further remove oxygen and extend shelf life.

Visual tricks and expert tips to give a small home a bigger, more open appearance and feel.

s apartments get smaller, maximising every square metre of space that you have becomes all the more important, especially if your home was never big enough to start with.

Thankfully, there are many clever ways to make a small apartment look and

feel bigger, with lighting, accessories, paint, storage solutions, and smart furniture placement.

We asked Rachel Eng,
Design Lead from interior
design firm, The Minimalist
Society, to share her best
advice for making your
space feel bigger.

Choose furniture wisely

"When seeking to amplify the perceived spaciousness of a small area, you can strategically choose which type of furniture to buy and how to place the furniture," says Rachel.

"Go with a couple of well-selected, larger furniture pieces rather than numerous small ones. This helps create a more open and uncluttered feel. Remember, less is more, so opt for a restrained approach with a few appropriately scaled large pieces. This involves incorporating multifunctional furniture, such as storage ottomans, to maximise utility."

Be transparent

"Transparent or glass furniture pieces, such as glass coffee tables and dining tables, may also help to create the illusion of more space by allowing light to pass through and maintaining a visual lightness," Rachel points out.

Try an open layout

If possible, leave empty some spaces to allow for a more open and breathable atmosphere. Rachel says that your furniture shouldn't obstruct natural pathways.

"In short, it's about personalising the space within the minimalist framework, making intentional choices to enhance both functionality and aesthetics." she adds.

Make a difference with accessories

If you have curtains or blinds, Rachel recommends hanging them closer to the ceiling and to use floor-length options to create the illusion of taller walls and a more expansive atmosphere. Light and sheer fabrics in window treatments also contribute to an airy feel.

With rugs, choose light colours and simple patterns, extending them just beyond the furniture to visually enlarge the floor space.

Play with mirrors

According to Rachel, mirrors serve as versatile tools in

creating the illusion of a larger space, but their effectiveness depends on thoughtful consideration of placement, size, and shape. For instance, strategically positioning mirrors across from windows or on walls perpendicular to them can maximise natural light reflection and expand the perceived dimensions of a room. Large mirrors, especially in smaller spaces, can help brighten and visually enlarge the area.

Tall order

Love tall bookshelves or highbacked chairs? Rachel says that these can work in a small home, but with some thought.

For example, tall and slim bookshelves help maximise vertical space without overwhelming the room horizontally like wide ones do. Similarly, high-backed chairs can be incorporated if they have a visually lightweight design, ensuring they don't dominate the space. You'll want to balance these taller pieces with lower-profile items to avoid a cramped feel.

"A mix of heights can add visual interest and create depth," Rachel adds.

Lighting matters

Proper lighting is crucial.
Rachel says that insufficient
lighting or relying solely
on harsh overhead lights
can diminish the sense of
openness. Likewise, opting
for dark colours on walls and
large furniture pieces can
absorb light, contributing to a
perception of an even smaller
space.

Be colour smart

Rachel advises using light, natural colours like white, beige and light grey, for walls and larger surfaces. These hues reflect light, creating an open and airy atmosphere. Light-coloured upholstery on furniture can also reflect light.

"Ensure a seamless visual flow by maintaining colour continuity between walls, furniture, and accessories, and maximise natural light to enhance the impact of the chosen colour palette," she adds.

f you're shopping for living or dining room furniture, you may be overwhelmed by the various styles, shapes and sizes out there. To help you make a more informed choice, Chris Zheng, Senior Buyer (Furniture) at Gain City Best-Electric, shares the advantages and drawbacks of different upholstery fabrics, shapes and materials.

Choose suitable upholstery fabrics

When buying a sofa, go with upholstery fabrics that are durable, especially if you have children and pets. Tightly woven fabrics in particular are long-lasting. You should also consider your budget, as some materials are more expensive than others.

"Microfibre and microsuede are affordable, hypoallergenic, scratch-resistant, stain-resistant, easy to clean, and versatile," says Chris. "Genuine leather is also hypoallergenic, stain-resistant, and easy to clean."

When it comes to dining chairs, Chris says that you have several options.



Synthetic fabrics like polyester and viscose (rayon) are durable and resistant to stains, wrinkling and fading, and come in a range of colours, patterns and textures. However, they absorb oil spills. and oil stains are often hard to remove.

"Leather is sophisticated, strong, has a natural shine, ages well, does not accumulate allergens or dust mites, and is easy to maintain," Chris continues.

"But leather dining chairs can be expensive and are prone to scratches."

And while velvet is soft and rich, with a slight sheen, velvet stains easily and can be a hassle to maintain. Plus. it's a magnet for dust and pet hair.



If you like natural fabrics, cotton and linen are good choices. Chris says that these are breathable and comfortable. resistant to wear-and-tear, and have anti-microbial properties (so they're resistant to mould and mildew).

The downside of natural fabrics is that they wrinkle and stain easily.

Know the best sofa styles for your space

If your living room is small, you'll want to take your time choosing the right sofa, as the wrong style or size can make a room look and feel smaller and cramped.

Chris recommends a twoseater and a one-seater, or a two- or three-seater sofa for small apartments.



Consider different dining table shapes

"Round tables are great for gatherings, but if the table is large (with a diameter of more than 120cm), your family may find it difficult to reach for items that are in the centre," Chris says.

"On the other hand, most long tables are no wider than 120cm, making it easier to reach for dishes. Plus, long tables are more practical for rectangular or long rooms.

"If you want a large round table, consider adding a lazy susan to it, so that you can access dishes easily. Alternatively, opt for an extendable round table for versatility."

Decide on the best material for your dining table

Wood tables, typically crafted from oak, walnut, maple, mahogany, pine, teak and acacia, are popular with many homeowners. Chris says that they're durable, aesthetically pleasing, versatile, and easy to repair. However, they can be costly and difficult to upkeep.

Affordable alternatives are composite or engineered wood tables made from MDF, plywood or particleboard with veneer. These tables are stable and look good, but Chris adds that they are not long-lasting or durable and are sensitive to moisture.

Marble dining tables are stylish, add a touch of luxury to your home, and are heat-resistant. Carrara, Calacatta, Statuario. Emperador, and Crema Marfil are common types of marble used for dining tables.

Drawbacks, according to Chris, include high porosity, their heavy weight, and their high cost. Marble dining tables are also hard to maintain.

Tempered glass dining tables are a good option for small homes, as they help create the illusion of a larger space. "This material is aesthetically pleasing and also easy to maintain," says

"Unfortunately, glass tables are fragile and may pose a safety issue. Additionally, they are seethrough, which may not work for everyone."



Counter intelligence

Kitchen islands and counters have become a fixture in many homes. Here's what to know about selecting and installing them.

What should you consider before installing either? Here's what we found out.





Islands and counters have become an essential consideration in kitchen designs and renovations, but they are not the same, says Low Yilin, Manager, The Alchemists Design.

"Islands are typically positioned in the centre of the kitchen, whereas counters are generally installed against a wall or as an extension of existing cabinets and counters, rather than as a freestanding unit."

They are functional and can enhance vour kitchen

"Both islands and counters

provide innovative storage solutions, offer plenty of worktop space for food preparation, improve the workflow in the kitchen, and may function as an additional dining area," says Yilin.

"If you have a smaller, new build, you may be more inclined towards an open-concept design, and having a kitchen island or counter can be a great way to demarcate the space. They also foster a communal atmosphere where cooking and socialising can coexist."

Size and placement matter

"The size of your kitchen may be the greatest influence on your decision to install an island or counter," says Yilin.







In small kitchens, for example, a centralised island may not be feasible. In such cases, Yilin says that a small counter on the side, against the wall, may be a more practical alternative.

If you intend for the counter to function as a bar, Yilin recommends fabricating it at a height of above one metre to accommodate barheight chairs. Conversely, if the counter is to serve as an additional workspace, she suggests installing it at the same height as the kitchen cabinetry.



Your design options are practically limitless

A popular design trend is the multifunctional kitchen island or counter. Yilin says that you can integrate storage options, seating and appliances to maximise the functionality of the unit.

Combining the kitchen island with your dining table, either perpendicularly or as a continuous stretch, is another great design idea.

"You can differentiate the two by varying their heights, with the island positioned higher than the dining area," Yilin points out.

"This design creates a seamless transition between the cooking and dining areas, making it perfect for entertaining guests or enjoying family meals. The dining table extension can be designed to match the island, creating a cohesive look in the kitchen."

Mixing materials and finishes allows you to express your personal style and create a unique kitchen centrepiece.

"Design-wise, I typically incorporate open shelving

at the corners of a kitchen island, with rounded edges to differentiate them from the standard kitchen cabinets," Yilin notes.

"I also often add decorative groove lines on the front side of the island or counter (the side that usually faces the living room), transforming the unit into a stand-out design feature."

If the size and positioning allow, Yilin suggests going for a fluid-shaped island, which lends movement and dynamism to the space without looking too stark. Rounded corners improve

> functionality and flow while helping to soften the look of the island or counter, she adds. It is also a more child- and elderfriendly option.

C tips to storage mastery

From decluttering to ideas for maximising cabinet capacity, here's how to organise like a pro.

Imost all of us have found ourselves with way more stuff than we need and hardly any space to put it. When your home is overrun by too many things, it can look cluttered and messy. And clutter isn't just bad for your physical and emotional health; it can be a fire hazard, too.

The key to keeping clutter at bay is to store your possessions the right way with these space-saving and organising tips.



Declutter before you organise

Clutter takes up more space than you realise, so items that you have no use for or no longer want shouldn't crowd your home.

"Prepare at least four large bags to sort out your possessions: Keep, Donate, Trash, and Miscellaneous," says Alex Chan from Kalm Organise.

"You shouldn't feel pressured to make

immediate decisions about what to keep, throw and donate. If you're unsure about an item, it can go into the Keep bag if it has sentimental value or the Miscellaneous bag so that you can decide what to do with it later."

Once the Donate and Trash bags have been removed from your home, you'll be in a better position to tackle the Miscellaneous bag, Alex adds.



"Hide" things

Never underestimate the usefulness of furniture items like bed frames with drawers, and ottomans, footstools and benches with storage.

These are great if you need extra space for books, blankets, chargers and photo albums, for example.



Get your possessions in order

Even after decluttering, you may still have more items than you have space for. In this case, you may want to organise your possessions according to category, such as Clothes, Books and Documents, Toiletries and so on.

"It's important to sort by category and not by location, as this allows you to see everything you own in the category you are tidying and lets you make better decisions on what to keep and discard," says Clara Chew, Konmari Consultant & Professional Organiser, and Founder of Reglow Living.

"First, decide on the category of items you want to tidy. Then, gather everything belonging to that category and lay them all out. This gives you a clear picture of what you own. Finally, decide what to keep by asking yourself if you like the item or not, and whether it 'sparks joy' in you. Is it something you want in your life?"



Optimise the space you have

Look at your cabinets, cupboards and shelving units and ask yourself if you're making good use of the space. For instance, instead of cramming everything into a cupboard, store them in stackable boxes, so you can fit more into the existing space.

Making effective use of a space means items are easier to retrieve, says Alex.

"You should be able to retrieve items with minimum effort – to this end, it's a good idea to invest in space maximisers like two-tier turntables, shelf inserts, pot organisers (to keep pots and lids separated), and so on."

With wardrobes that only have shelves, Clara recommends buying readymade plastic drawers or rectangular baskets. This allows clothes to be folded and placed in a row instead of being stacked.

"The problem with stacks is that the items at the bottom tend to be difficult to reach and you end up not using them," she adds.

Clara prefers magazine stands for keeping papers and magazines tidy, and foldable shelves to create more space, such as in cupboards below the sink, for example.



Keep it simple

Clara advises against devising complex storage methods.

"Storage should ideally be kept simple," she explains.

"Storage methods work best when things can be easily retrieved and returned after use. This ensures your home will be tidy, as items will always be where they belong."



Buy the right type of storage

Decide how you want to store and organise your possessions, and then invest in the correct containers or organisers. Large tubs, for instance, are perfect for toys; stackable containers help to keep tools, stationery and craft supplies neatly separated; shelf inserts are useful for creating more space in your pantry; and wire baskets help keep a T-shirt collection tidy.

Finally, opt for clear containers so that you can see what's inside easily and quickly.


How to child proof your home

household hazards and keep your little ones safe.




t's not easy keeping an eye on your kids all the time. They move fast and are always exploring their surroundings, and even when you think they can't possibly run into trouble, something happens and they end up hurting themselves.



"Young children are more accident-prone and more likely to injure themselves compared to older kids because their motor skills are not quite as developed. Plus they're naturally more curious and less aware of the dangers around them," says Dr Harikerishnan.

The best way to prevent these accidents is by familiarising yourself with the most common hazards and taking the appropriate steps to keep the home a safe space for your precious ones.



Here. Dr Harikerishnan shares his top tips for preventing littles ones from getting hurt at home.

Danger: Sharp table edges/

What to do: Kids can't help but run into furniture sometimes. Avoid buying sharp-ended furniture or cover sharp edges with corner guards.

Danger: Small or sharp items What to do: To prevent choking and cuts, keep small and sharp items out of your children's reach. For example, store them on a high shelf that your kids cannot access, or lock them away in a cabinet.







Danger: Hot items or liquids (like food, oil and water) What to do: These can scald and burn the skin and potentially even cause disfigurement. Make sure your tots stay away from the kitchen or install a gate to block their entrance to the kitchen. Keep hot items and liquids out of their reach and always test the water temperature before showering or bathing them. Install stove and oven guards to prevent little hands from touching these appliances when in use.



Danger: Slippery surfaces What to do: Use anti-slip mats and ensure that your floors are dry at all times.



Danger: Loose, unsecured items

> What to do: Secure furniture to the wall so that it doesn't tip over and fall on your kids. Use childproof locks on drawers. Replace tablecloths with nonslip place mats and put small stools away when not in use.



Danger: Household chemicals and medication What to do: Store all medication and detergents. disinfectants and other cleaning agents in a cupboard and lock the cupboard with a childproof lock.




Danger: Open containers of water

What to do: Prevent drowning by keeping toilet seat covers down and never leaving containers of water unattended.



Danger: Slamming doors What to do: These can crush small children who are in the way. Use a door stopper.



While waiting for medical attention, you may need to give your tot acute care. Dr Harikerishnan shares some tips and advice:



- Always keep a first-aid kit at home and replenish its contents accordingly.
- If your child is bleeding, clean the injury site with a clean cloth and apply pressure/compression to the site.
- Learn what to do in case of choking if you take a first-aid course, for instance, you'll be taught to give five blows to your child's back when he's choking or to do chest compressions, and so on.
- Learn how to do simple CPR (cardiopulmonary resuscitation) on infants and children. This knowledge will come in handy if your little one loses
- If your child has fallen from a height, do not move them if you suspect that his neck or back is injured unless there is an immediate danger. Keep your child still and calm until help arrives.
- In the event of a burn injury, run cool water over the burn site for at least 20 minutes and then apply clean dressing to the burn.

CNY taboos & traditions you should know

You've probably heard of some of these before, but others may be new or surprising. Homeowners, take note of some of these sensible tips.

ealth, happiness and longevity are common themes that arise during the two-week Chinese New Year period. For those who celebrate, this means following traditional customs that are said to attract good fortune and good health, and avoiding certain taboos that are considered unlucky. Of course, these traditions and superstitions aren't evidence-based – so you can take them with a grain of salt – but they're fascinating and fun to know.



Avoid cleaning your home on the first day

If you have to clean and declutter your home, don't do it on the first day, as the act of sweeping or discarding of rubbish at the start of the New Year symbolises the clearing out of wealth and good luck.



There's a right way to hang those lucky decorations

Hang vertical couplets on each side of a doorway; position horizontal banners above doorframes; and paste cutouts on doors and windows. As for the Fu character, many people deliberately place it upside down to signify "good fortune arriving". (In Chinese, the word for "upside down" sounds similar to the word for "arrive".)



If you break something, wrap it up

Breaking a glass, bowl, plate, cup, vase or mirror is considered bad luck. Of course, we can't always prevent accidents, so if you do break something, wrap the shards in red paper and discard the package when the festive season is over.



Put sharp objects away

Try not to use sharp objects, like scissors, knives, nail clippers and needles on the first day, as this represents "cutting off" wealth and good luck. (This might also be why cutting one's hair on the first day is considered taboo.)

Don't visit anyone on the third day

The third day is commonly known as Chi Kou Ri, or the day of the red mouth. Older Chinese who are superstitious believe that a red mouth may result in arguments, so they avoid visiting loved ones on this day. They also call this day Chi Gou Ri, or the day of the red dog. In Chinese mythology, the red dog is the God of Anger, and people are said to be more likely to quarrel with others on this day.



No books, please

We're all for learning, but avoid buying books during the entire Chinese New Year period. The Chinese word for book, "shu", sounds the same as the word for "lose", so buying books after welcoming the New Year is regarded as inviting misfortune into your life. You should also avoid giving books to people, as this is considered wishing bad luck upon them.



Schedule that nap for another day

Taking an afternoon nap in your cosy home boosts alertness and relieves stress, but napping on the first day is not recommended as it means you'll be lazy all year long.

Jeffrey: Turkey dishes here aren't as well-received as they are in Western countries. As I deliberated on how to inject my own twist into the customary Christmas dinner, it came to me – one of our best-selling dishes here at Happy Café is our lamb chop. It's halal, easy to find and incredibly forgiving to prepare even for novice chefs.

For non-fans, lamb tends to have a gamey smell.

Jeffrey: The key to removing its odour is to season it well. I infuse my cuts of lamb with a special spice rub made from rosemary, thyme and garlic. You can add in your favourite herbs into the mix. If you like to take it up a notch, you can poke holes into your lamb cuts and fill them with garlic cloves. Not only will they help remove the smell, they'll keep the lamb tender during the cooking process.

How do you ensure that your lamb cut always turns out perfect?

Jeffrey: All you really need is patience. I give my lamb plenty of time to fully absorb my spice rub before slow-cooking it for another 4 hours in tomato stock (hence, the lamb shanks' reddish hue). One more thing that both novices and veterans often overlook – ensuring that the lamb has enough liquid to fully simmer. Keep extra stock on hand in case your lamb shanks need a top up.

Mashed potatoes are one of those dishes that are easy to prepare, but difficult to master.

Jeffrey: Russet potatoes are really the way to go if you want a mash that is silky and soft. While it is common knowledge that mashed potatoes have to go with a lot of butter, I find that adding cream takes its richness to a whole new level. For an extra kick, I like to add just a smitch of cinnamon powder.



Slow-Cooked Lamb Shanks with Mashed Potatoes

(Happy Cafe)

LAMB SHANKS

1kg Lamb Shanks
1/4 cup Tomato Paste
1500ml Pronto Tomato
(or any Tomato Broth)
700ml Water
1 Carrot (sliced)
2 cups Chopped Onions

Spice Rub:

- 1 teaspoon Salt
- 1 teaspoon Black Pepper
- 1 teaspoon Paprika
- 1 teaspoon Flour
- 2 teaspoons Oil
- 2 sprigs Rosemary
- 3 Dried Bay Leaves
- 5 cloves Garlic

Preparation:

- 1 Mix the condiments and herbs to create a spice rub. Let the lamb shanks rest in the rub for 45 minutes.
- 2 Heat up cooking oil in a large non-stick pan over medium heat. Sear the outer layer of the lamb shank until the skin is golden brown.
- **3** Toss in the vegetables and give a light fry. Add in the tomato paste and mix well.

- **4** Transfer to a large crockpot. Fill the pot with Pronto Tomato base and water and let the contents boil at high heat.
- **5** Once it reaches a boil, add in the lamb shanks and let it simmer over medium heat for 15 minutes. Stir constantly.
- **6** Reduce the heat to low and let the shanks slow-cook for 4 hours.

MASHED POTATOES

1kg Russet Potatoes (peeled and cut evenly) ¼ cup Cream (optional) 4 tablespoons Butter

- 1 teaspoon Salt
- 1 teaspoon Black Pepper

Preparation:

- **1** Add potatoes and water into a large pot and boil over high heat until tender.
- 2 Drain the potatoes, and mash until smooth. Add in butter (and cream if using) gradually.
- **3** Season with salt and black pepper.

What is it about an abalone dish that screams "Huat ah!"?

Ken: It isn't the abalone dish itself, but rather the Fatt Choy that typically comes with it! Consider Gong Hei Fatt Choy, the greeting that is expressed during Chinese New Year to mean "wishing you prosperity". How much more auspicious can it be?

Speaking of broths, how do you create a delicious one from scratch?

Ken: Everything we use during our prep, whether it is the water we soused the shiitake mushrooms in or the brine that our chicken bones are boiled in, goes back into the broth. The chicken stock we add in later charges up all these natural ingredients, releasing a natural sweetness and savouriness that makes the broth so rich.

How can home cooks avoid the bane of Chinese New Year – rubbery abalone?

Ken: If you are getting canned abalones, steam the entire can with the lid firmly closed. Many chefs I know drain them, but I have learnt that the packing liquid is actually great as a steaming liquid. The can's compact nature also ensures that the abalone is cooked evenly.

Any simple tips that actually make a huge difference in preparing an abalone dish?

Ken: Get the best kind of condiments there are in the market! Items like soy sauce, oyster sauce, sesame sauce and even abalone sauce have many variants. Read the labels and look out for keywords like "Premium" and "Superior".



Braised Abalone with Oyster

(Lucky Cuisine)

1 can Abalone
12 Dried Oysters
12 Dried Shiitake Mushrooms
4 cloves Garlic (chopped)
10g Fatt Choy
1 cup Chicken Stock
1 tablespoon Dark Soy Sauce
1 tablespoon Chinese
Cooking Wine
2 tablespoons Soy Sauce
2 tablespoons Cooking Oil
4 tablespoons Oyster Sauce

Preparation:

1 Soak the dried oysters, fatt choy and shiitake mushrooms in separate bowls of warm water for 1-2 hours. Set aside the rehydrated oysters, fatt choy and mushrooms and save the water.

- 2 Steam the canned abalones (without removing the lid) for 30–45 minutes.
- 3 Heat up cooking oil in a large pan over medium heat and gently fry the chopped garlic.
- **4** Add in shiitake mushrooms and oysters and cook for 4 minutes or until they begin to brown.
- **5** Stir in the soy sauce, dark soy sauce, oyster sauce and Chinese cooking wine and fatt choy. Mix well.
- **6** Transfer the contents into a cooker and add in the steamed abalones, chicken stock and brine. Simmer for 20 minutes.
- **7** Thicken the broth with a cornstarch slurry (1:2 ratio of cornstarch to water) and serve.


